Our Church-Guide Lines

Mask wearing is OPTIONAL as long you can maintain a distance of at least six feet from others who are not in your immediate family. This meets the standards set by Lancaster County.

- 1] Mask exception: Someone who has a medical/physical condition that makes wearing a mask unworkable or someone who can maintain a distance of at least six feet from others who are not in their immediate family.
- 2] If not feeling well on a Sunday, please remain home.
- 3] Offering plate will be placed on a stand in the entryway.
Offering may be deposited prior to or after service.
- 4] When entering the building, please apply hand sanitizer.
Sanitizer will be placed near each entrance.
- 5] The interim streaming technology is located at entrance of sanctuary, please navigate around the equipment carefully when being seated.
- 6] Seating: Seating will be spaced. Pews with Bibles/hymn books laying in them are "blocked off." Families may sit together, otherwise, maintain social distance.
- 7] Coffee and treats will not be served.
- 8] Although cumbersome, masked attendees are invited to sing, if so desired. If unmasked, please do not sing. Only the praise team is permitted to sing unmasked while distanced from attendees.
