



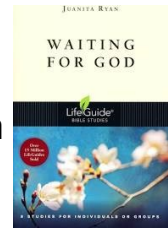

We will follow the guidelines for Covid by the LLCHD that are in place at the time of Vacation Bible School. Contact information is Judy Nyhof; her address is in church directory.



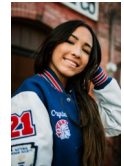
# Holland
