

Your family is invited to attend activities for children and adults:

Wednesday Nights Alive for 2 years old through High School. Our classes have a Bible Class lesson and our younger children have a craft project. Wednesday Nights Alive will start September 15th and go to March. You do not have to register your children to attend, but it does help in planning. Registering your child will be available on our web page -thehollandchurch.org

A meal is served at 5:30 p.m. until 6:10 p.m. when the children go to their classes. The meal is a free-will donation, but not necessary. The meals are open to all even if you don't have children attending. We are excited to be able to serve our meals in our fellowship hall.

For adults:
