If you are not vaccinated, please be extremely cautious. Church recommends a mask and a minimum six foot distance from others not from your household.



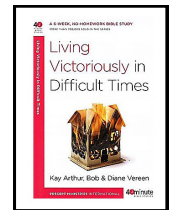
