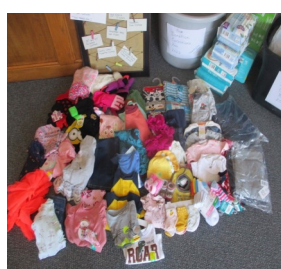
\$10 gas station gift cards to help families who struggle getting to and from appointments

There will be a party on March 30, More information later.

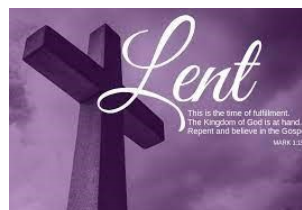


Your help is needed for craft supplies for our 2022 Vacation Bible School:
