WinGS (Women in God’s Service) mission for May is Friendship Home. Their mission is to empower freedom from domestic violence. Their website explains: *“Domestic violence is a pattern of physical assaults, threats and coercive behaviors used to maintain control over a current or former intimate partner. Abusive behaviors can include ongoing verbal, emotional, sexual, physical, psychological, and economic abuse, and typically get worse over time. The National Coalition Against Domestic Violence estimates that domestic violence is a crime that affects up to 30% of American women.* Currently, their biggest needs are toilet paper, paper towels, sunscreen and bug spray for adults and children. They would also appreciate summer toys for children.
