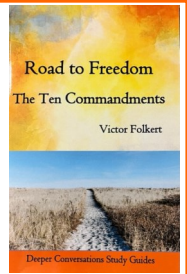


WiNGS (Women in God's Service)

pink erasers	loose leaf notebook paper		

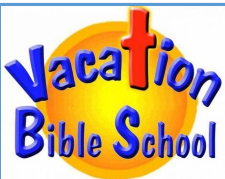


These items are due Sunday, July 23.
