YFC Camp & Trip Fundraiser

Last year at Camp, 14 students came to Christ and 5 were baptized. At our Spring Break trips, 60 students engaged in worship and devotional activities. At Worlds of Fun, 150 students connected with a Campus Life leader. Through all of this, 86 students made decisions to follow Jesus. However, last year we had a total expense for these events of \$39,876. We never want finances to be a reason a student cannot attend one of our events. Here are some items to consider for donation: **everyday clothing** for boys or girls (preemie, newborn, 0-3 mo., 12 mo., 18 mo., 24 mo-2T, 3T) **sleepers** for boys or girls (newborn & 0-3 mo., zip-up style) **sleep sacks** for boys or girls (newborn- 6 mo.) **shoes** for boys or girls (newborn-size 7) **Items for baby baskets:** baby bottles (new, 8 oz) baby wash, baby shampoo, baby lotion (10-ish oz. size), hooded bath towels, pacifiers (NB-6 mo.), rattles and teething rings, bibs and hats.
