two Bible studies.**

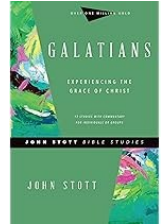
Men's Bible study group meets on Wednesday night at 6:30.

They very much appreciate the support we give them through our donations.



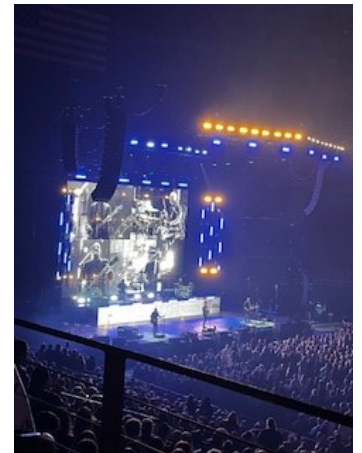
